# **Quick Start Guide for Students**

### How to log into Blackboard:

- 1. When using a computer on campus, the screen will automatically open to the college Home page.
  - Find Helpful Links and then select Online Education
  - Once that link opens up you will be on the sign in page of Blackboard.
  - Sign in with Student ID number and password.
  - Then you will be in Blackboard.
- If you are using a computer off campus, you can access Blackboard by typing <u>myclass.kckcc.edu</u> into the address bar at the top of the page. Then type in Student ID and password.
- 3. In Blackboard the very first page you land on is referred to as **My Home**. You will find a box titled **My Courses**.
- 4. To enter the class, click on the link to the class.
- 5. Once you have clicked on the link to your on ground class, you might feel a little bit anxious. So take some time and just breathe. There is nothing to be afraid of, so take some time, relax and just take it all in before you start randomly clicking.
- The column on the left side of the page is called the Course Menu. On the Course Menu you will find the links to everything you will need to access in the class.
  - a. By clicking on the **Content** Link you have access to all the documents, videos, images, assignments/drop boxes (for written assignments), tests or surveys.
  - b. Course Messages is where instructors will communicate in the class. The purpose being to keep communication inside of Blackboard so it doesn't get lost in Campus Email.
  - c. **My Grades** is where you can access your graded assignments 24/7.
  - d. If you are having a problem with any of the Blackboard features, you can click on the **Help** link and find documents and videos that can walk you through the necessary steps.
